


# **We Help FRESH Pantry Volunteer Opportunities**

The We Help FRESH Pantry offers FRESH and nutritious produce, meats, dairy, food staples, and hygiene items for FREE to any Pinellas County resident in need. Food items are distributed via two options: indoor choice and drive-thu.

The SPFC Volunteer Program offers multiple shift options for volunteers Monday through Friday weekly.

For these opportunities, we ask volunteers for a commitment of at least one 4-hour shift each week for a minimum of 3-6 months.
