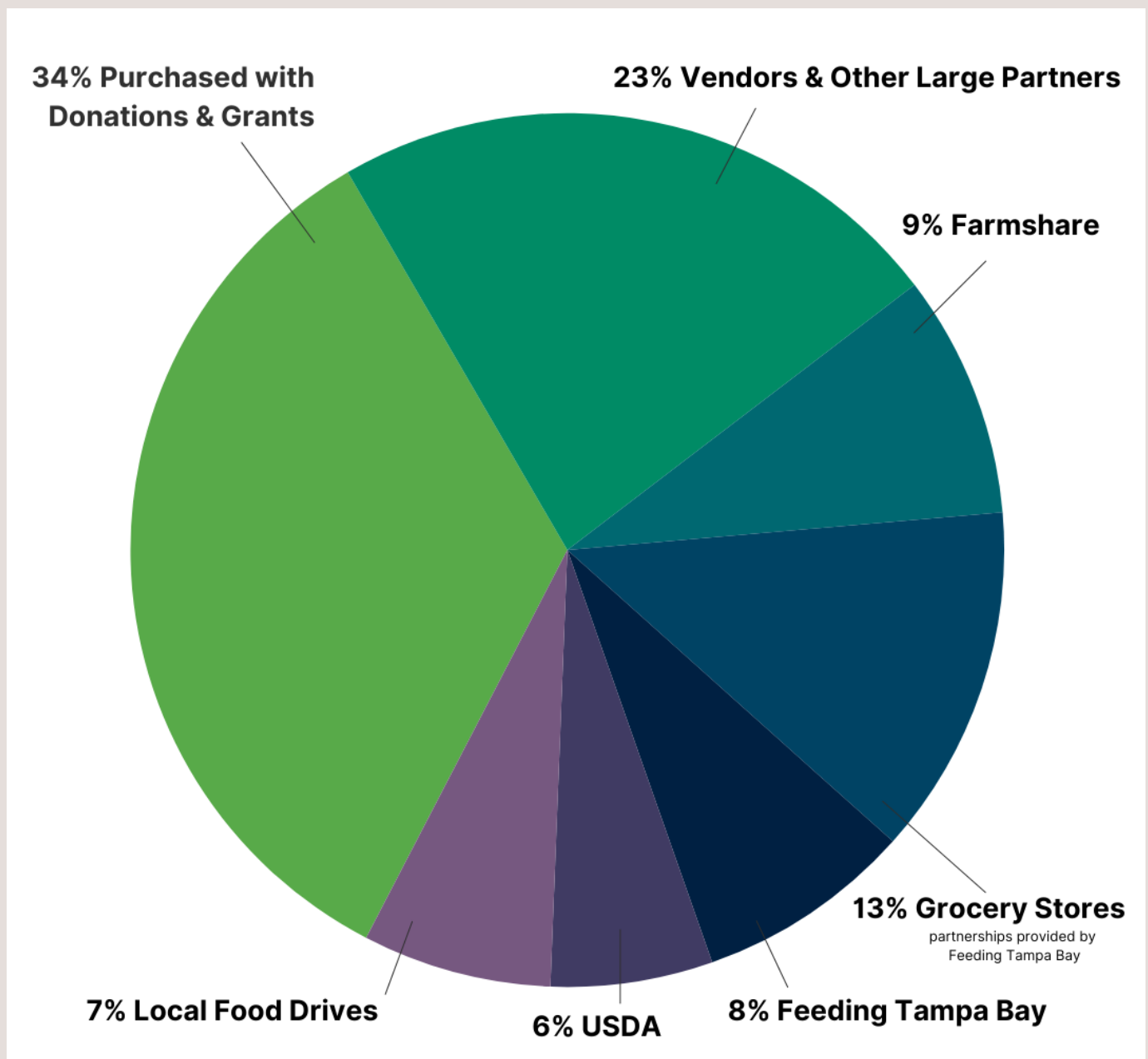

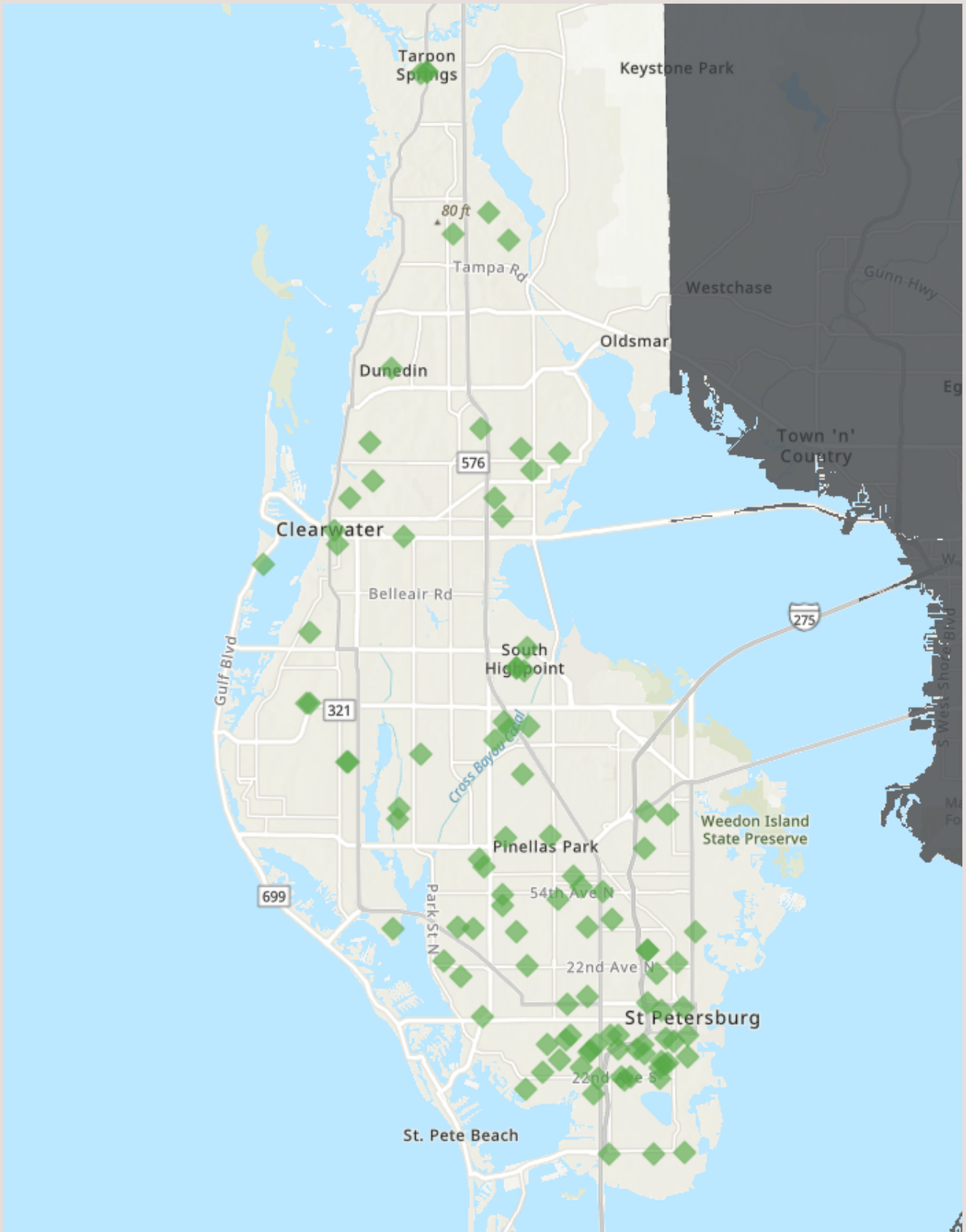
SPFC Food Sources

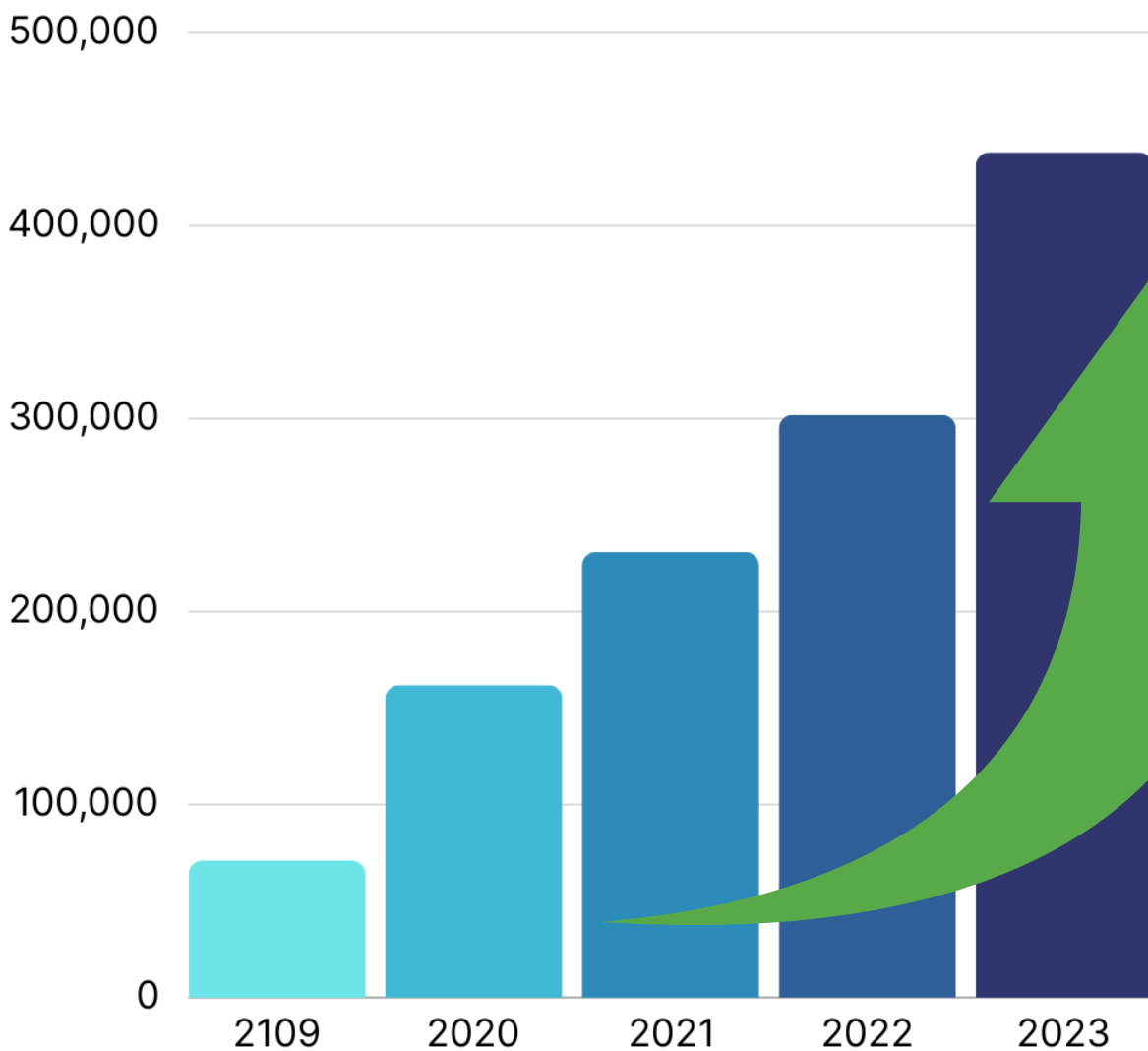

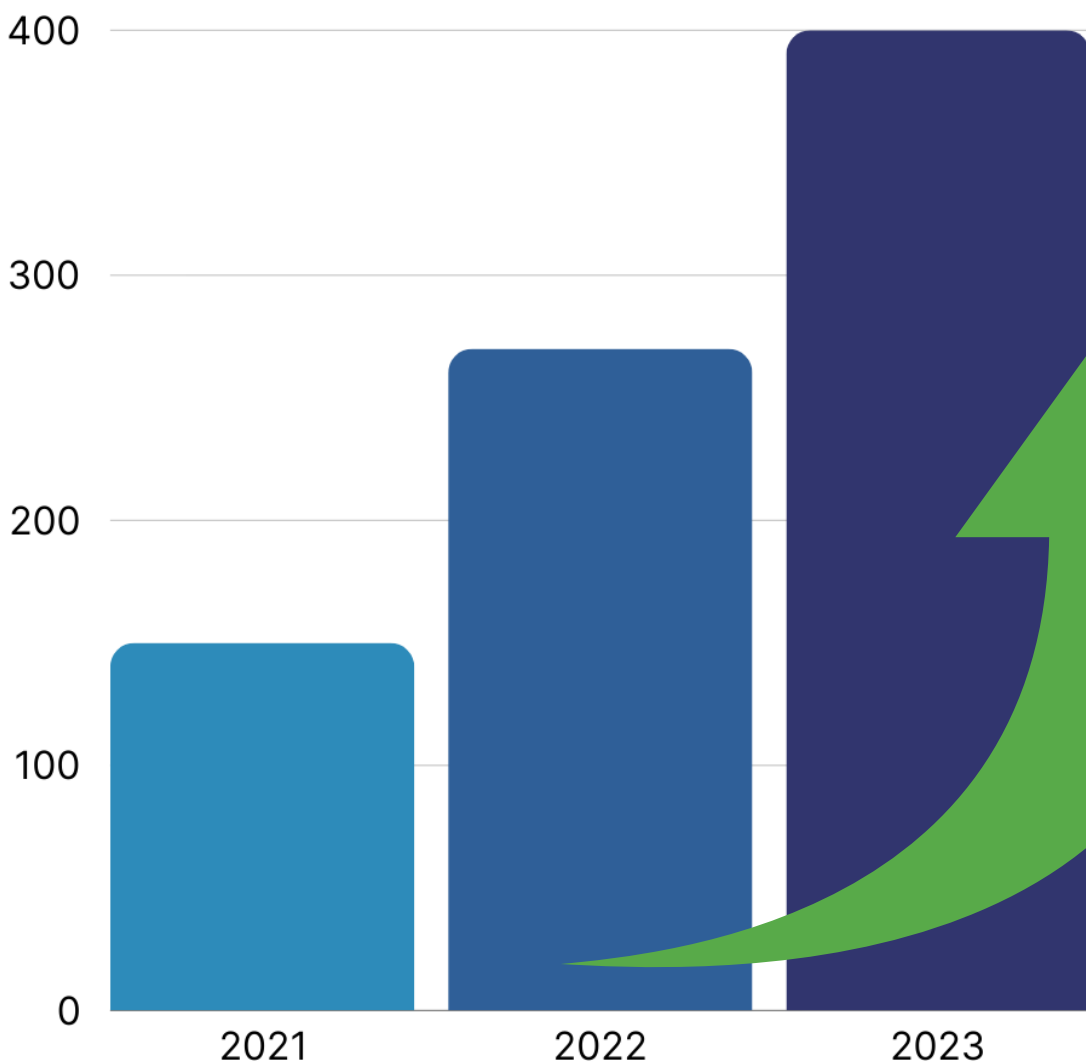

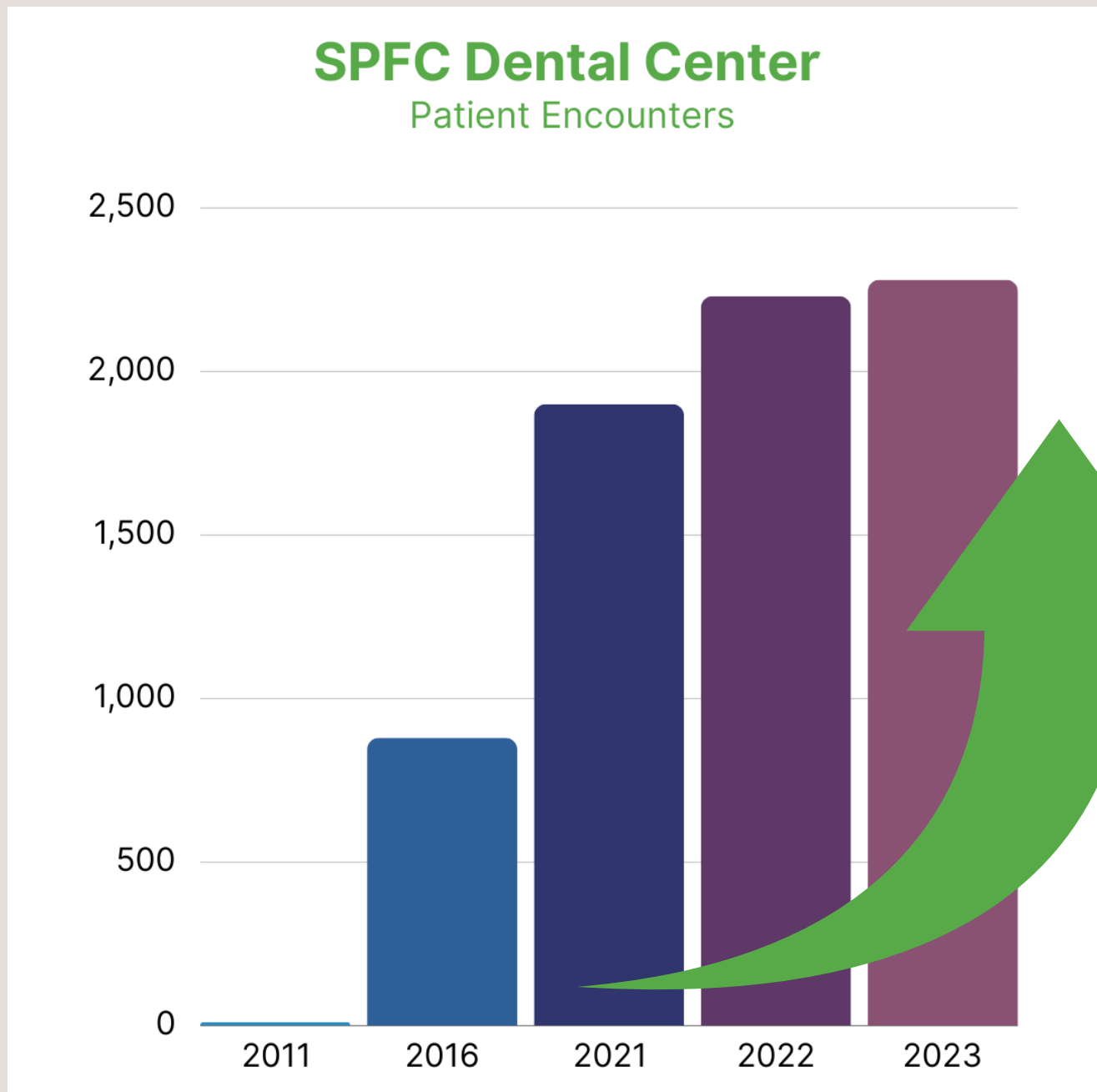
Unique Patients Being Managed Per Month

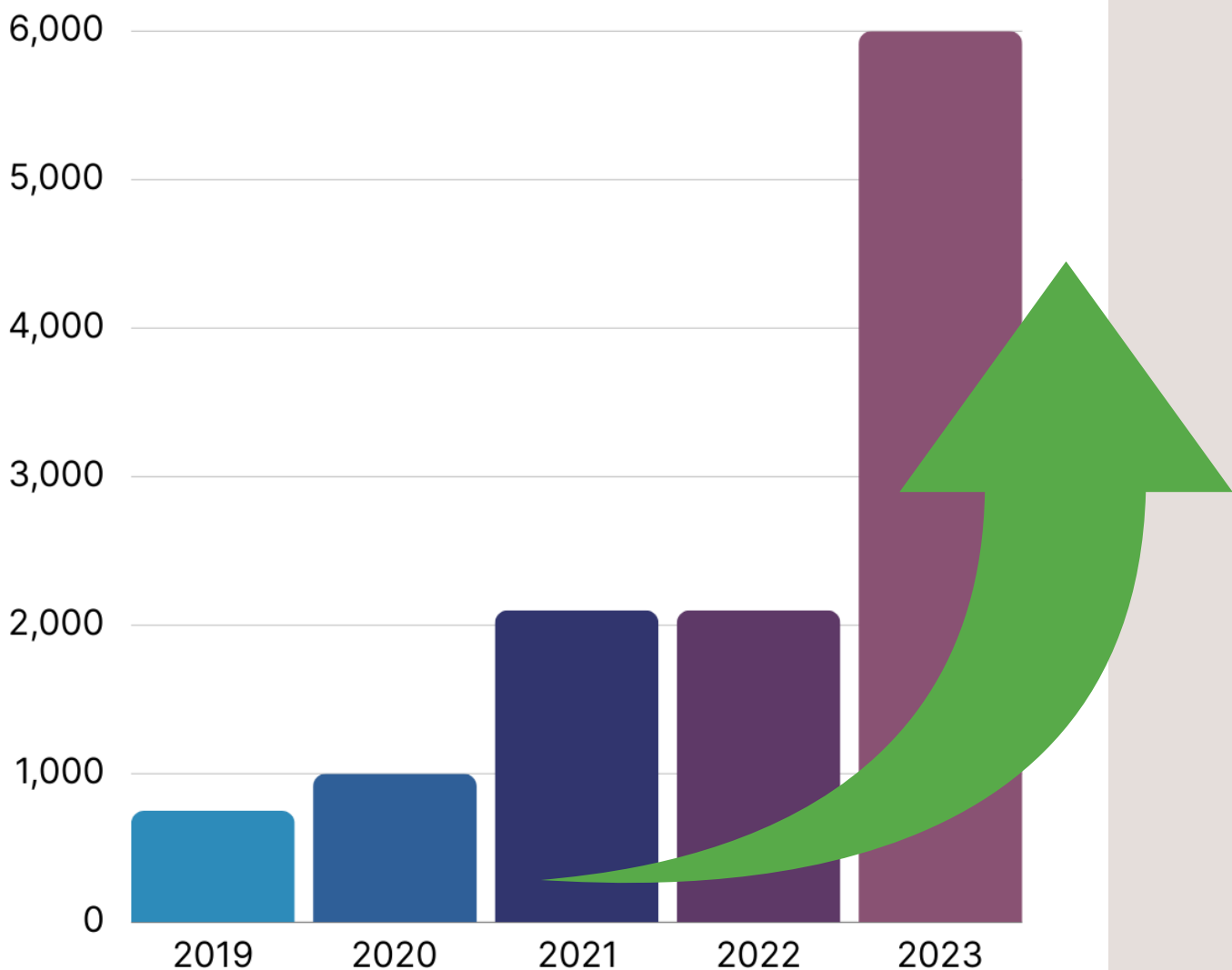


SPFC Prescription Health Program

SPFC Prescription Health Program Patient Encounters

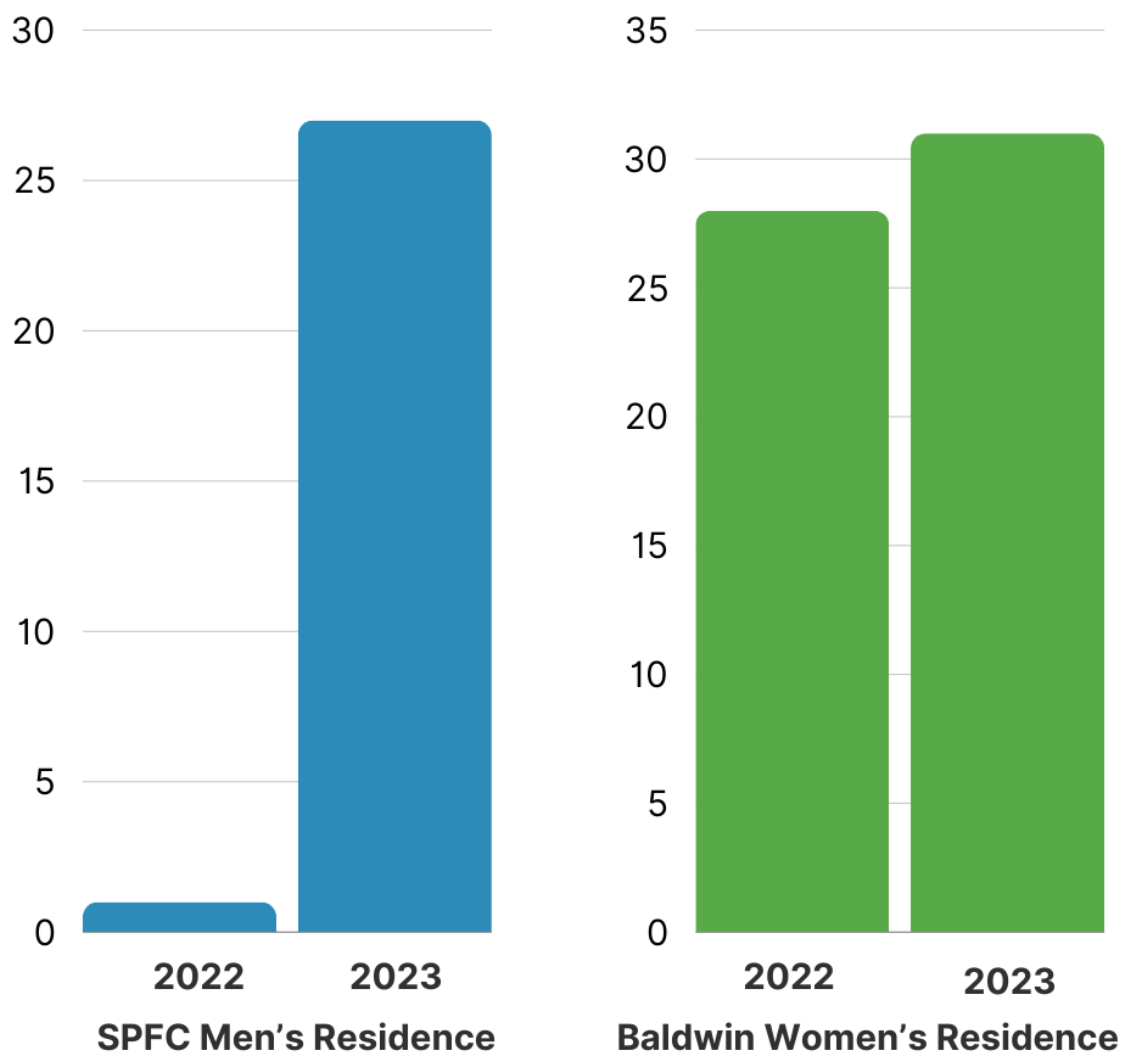


SPFC Supportive Housing

The Baldwin Women’s Residence (BWR) and the SPFC Men’s Residence participate in group and individual counseling sessions to increase resilience and work to address co-occurring diagnoses in a trauma-informed manner. Our residences housed 183 men and women last year.

Half of BWR residents participated in individual counseling in addition to group sessions.

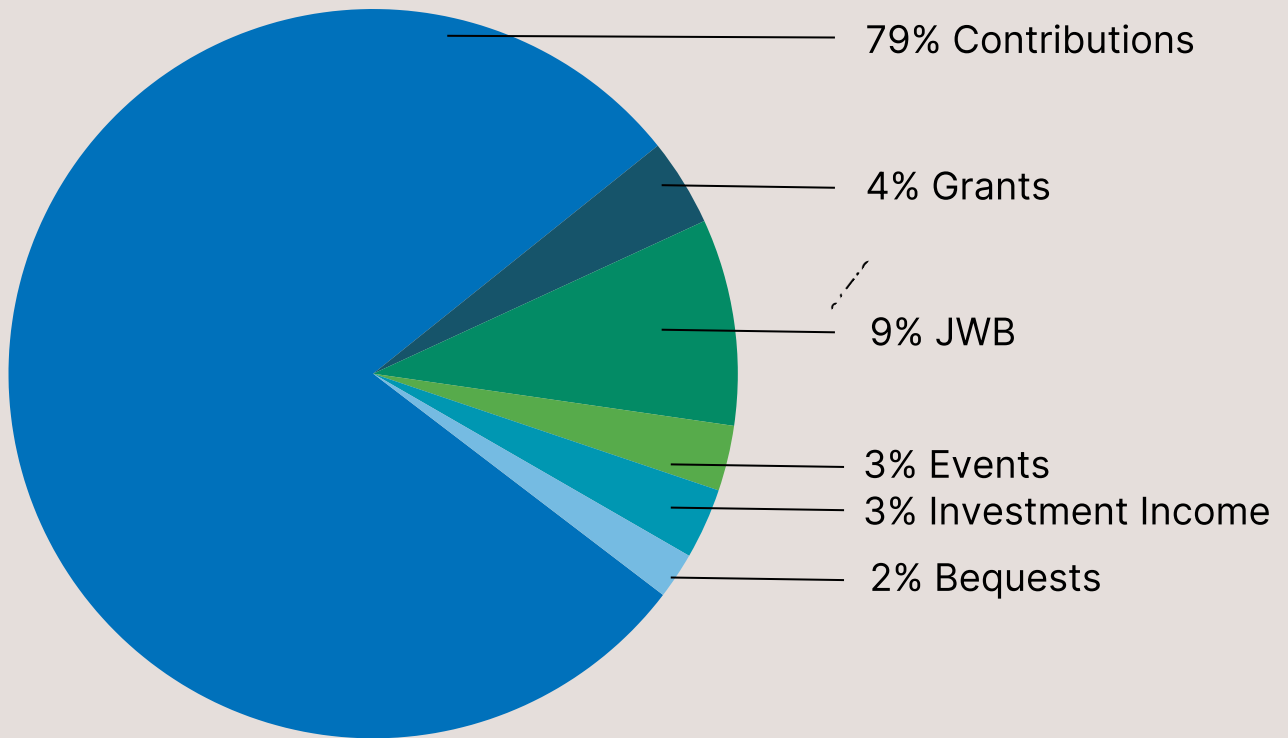
Absolutely the best place to pick up the pieces of your life. Excellent support and resources. Some of the happiest days of my life!

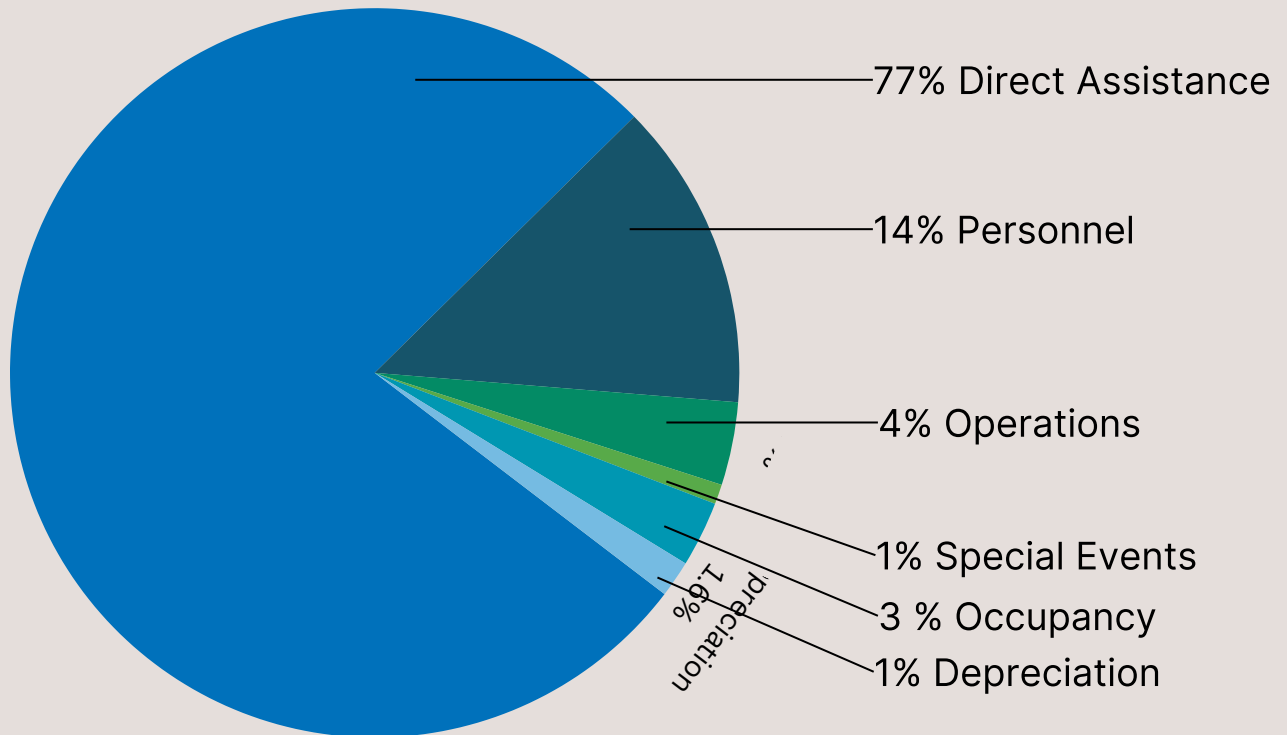
